A hierarchy selection may not be supported by an implementation. A **searchServiceProblem** with the value **id-pr-unavailableHierarchySelect** has been defined for that purpose. However, the procedures do not take that situation into account.

Add to the following after item 2) in 13.3 and renumber subsequent items:

- 3) If there are hierarchy select options in the request that are not supported by the DSA and which are not covered by 2), then the **notification** shall contain:
 - a searchServiceProblem notification attribute with the value id-prunavailableHierarchySelect;
 - a serviceType notification attribute having as value the serviceType component of the searchrule; and
 - a hierarchySelectList notification attribute having as value a bitstring identifying the unsupported hierarchy selection options.
