While the description of the cross certificate pair attribute includes the optional 'reverse' element, it does not clarify the conditions under which this is required to be populated.

11. Solution Proposed by the Source:

In the first paragraph of the description of the cross certificate pair attribute (that begins "The forward elements \dots "), add the following as a new $3^{\rm rd}$ sentence.

"If a CA issues a certificate to another CA, and the subject CA is not a subordinate to the issuer CA in a hierarchy, then the issuer CA must place that certificate in the reverse element of the crossCertificatePair attribute of its own directory entry."
