10. Nature of Defect:

Clause 8.1.5 of the 4<sup>th</sup> edition text clarifies that self-signed certificates, if encountered in a certification path, shall be ignored. However, the path processing text does not clearly indicate this rule and should be updated accordingly.

11. Solution Proposed by the Source:

*In the 3rd edition text, in clause 12.4.3, add the following sentence immediately after the introductory sentence to the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 6<sup>th</sup> bullet lists. These introductory sentences begin with "The following checks are applied to a certificate" and "For an intermediate certificate, the following …"* 

Self-signed certificates, if encountered in the path, are ignored.

In the  $4^{th}$  edition text, add the following sentence as a new second sentence in the first paragraph in clause 10.5.1 and as a new second sentence in the first paragraph in clause 10.5.2:

Self-signed certificates, if encountered in the path, are ignored.
